## 2020 Track On 2 - Track Rules and Regulations

- 1. Under no circumstances will any profane or abusive language be directed toward any official or employee of The Track On 2. Violation of this directive will result in an immediate and indefinite suspension from any, and all, privileges associated with The Track On 2 and Event Centre.
- Any violation or infraction deemed to be "not in the best interest of harness racing" is subject to suspension from any, and all, privileges associated with The Track On 2.
- 3. Any person(s) jogging and/or training a racehorse must be a member in good standing with the Alberta Standardbred Horse Association (ASHA) and Standardbred Canada. Unlicensed persons are not permitted on the racetrack surface in control of a horse.
- 4. The speed limit is 15 KM per hour on roads between and around barns. Vehicles exceeding the limit shall be removed and denied further entry into the stable area.
- 5. Helmets must be worn at all times when on the track jogging and/or training horses. For any training mile, warming up or racing, helmets must be securely fastened. Only certified helmets will be allowed at The Track On 2.
- 6. During a Live Racing event, all persons warming up horses must wear driving colors, or a training suit that is approved by Horse Racing Alberta (HRA). All grooms and trainers must be properly attired.
- 7. All equipment, including driving helmets, race bikes, jog carts and blankets must be of clean appearance while on the track or in the paddock area. Equipment should be free of any dirt and/or debris and in good repair.
- 8. All terms and conditions for stall rental are outlined in the Stall Rental Agreement.

- 9. Saddlecloths must be taken off a horse in the Paddock area. Under no circumstances shall the saddlecloth and head number be removed on the racetrack. All saddlecloths must be returned to the same area they were picked up from. A loss of, or damage to, a saddlecloth is the responsibility of the horse assigned that number on a particular race day.
- 10. All spectators must stand behind the fence to view a race. Only horses warming up and racing, along with the respective trainers and drivers may be allowed on the track during the course of a race card.
- 11. ABSOLUTELY NO DOGS IN THE BARN AREA.
- 12. The consumption of alcohol is not permitted in the Barns, Paddock and Ship-In Barns. Any persons in control of a horse shall be subject to drug and alcohol screening.
- 13. The use, sale, advertisement, growth, and or preparation of Cannabis or any derivative of Cannabis (indoors or outdoors) is strictly prohibited on property of The Track on 2.
- 14. Smoking is not permitted inside the stabling barns, ship-in barn and/or paddock.
- 15. Smoking is not permitted on the racetrack within 2-hours prior to post time of the first race on the program.
- 16. All participants in racing at The Track On 2 (including trainers, owners, drivers and caretakers) shall abide by all the rules and regulations of The Track On 2, Horse Racing Alberta (HRA), Alberta Standardbred Horse Association (ASHA) and Standardbred Canada in regards to the conduct of the race meeting.
