5 THINGS TO SAY

- 1. Name of the track; Track on 2
- 2. Race number; Race 4
- 3. Amount of bet: \$2
- 4. Number of the horse;
- 5. Type of bet;

"I'd like to bet on the Track on 2, race 4, \$2 bet on horse #3 to win."



BASIC BETS

WIN: Your horse finishes in first place.

PLACE: Your horse finishes first or second place.

SHOW: Your horse finishes in any of first, second or third place.

ACROSS THE BOARD: Choose a single horse and place 3 equal bets for that horse to win, place or show.

QUICK PICKS: A randomly selected bet placed for you.

EXOTIC BETS

EXACTOR: Choose the order of the first two horses to cross the finish line.

TRIACTOR: Choose the order of the first three horses to cross the finish line

SUPERFECTA: Choose the order of the first four horses to cross the finish line.

DAILY DOUBLE: Choose the winning horse in two consecutive races.

PICK 3/PICK 4/PICK 5: Choose the winning horse in 3/4/5 consecutive races.

BOXING FEATURE BETS: Boxing a bet means that the horses that you have selected can come in any order. For example, with an exactor bet on horse #3 and #8, if you box it, you essentially have two different bets, horse #3 1st/horse #8 2nd AND horse #8 1st/horse #3 2nd.

THE ODDS

Odds are determined by how much is bet on each horse to WIN; the more that is bet, the more people are sharing in the winnings and the less that winning horse will pay. For example, if a horse has 10-1 odds, on a \$2 bet to win, you would receive approximately \$22.

EXAMPLES ON A \$2 BET

Odds	1-2	8-5	2-1	7-2	10-1
Pays	\$3	\$5.20	\$6	\$9	\$22
